Summary of overall purpose/goal of position:

The Lone Peak Police Department is currently accepting applications for a full-time position of Patrol Officer with benefits.

- Performs traffic enforcement while patrolling to insure the safety of the city streets.

- Testify in court to present verbal and physical evidence regarding traffic and criminal procedures.
- When called upon by the police administration, make public presentations to the community.
- Be available by phone, cell phone to call-outs for special assignments or critical incidents.

EDUCATION: Must possess a high school diploma or GED. A degree from an accredited college is preferred.

KNOWLEDGE: Knowledge of state and federal law, traffic codes, city ordinances, and departmental policies and procedures. Entry level knowledge of police methods, practices, and procedures or have the ability to acquire and apply the knowledge.

SKILLS: Communication in both written and oral format. Skills as taught at POST, the field training program in the ongoing department training.

TO APPLY:

- Submit a completed Lone Peak Police Department job application.
- Submit a résumé with a cover letter.
- Submit a copy of your POST LEO certification or SFO certification if you will be obtaining your LEO certification within 30 days of hire.
- Include a copy of your valid driver's license.
- Include proof of valid high school diploma or completion of GED.
- POST LEO certifiable within 30 days of hire.
- Be at least 21 years of age.

Background Investigation: A full background investigation, including drug screen and fingerprints will be performed prior to appointment to this position.

Salary Range: Starting wage for full-time officers with experience is \$27.47/hour. Years of full-time law enforcement experience can be matched, depending on qualifications and certifications at the discretion of the Chief of Police.
